



# BASIC GOAT & SHEEP FEEDER

## Component Parts:

### Hardware Package

- (20) 5/16" lock nuts
- (14) 5/16" x 2" bolts
- (6) 5/16" x 1" bolts
- (2) c-brackets

- (2) 1/2" wrenches

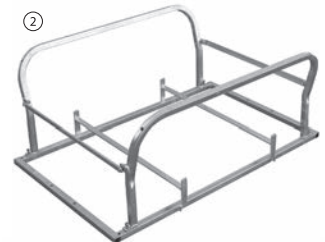

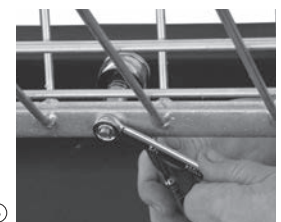
## Assembly & Installation Instructions:

**Note:** Do not tighten lock nuts until all bolts and component parts are in place.

1. With base upside down, bolt legs into place using 5/16" x 2" bolts. (Do not tighten completely)
2. Bolt leg cross braces into place using 5/16" x 1" bolts. Now tighten all bolts.
3. Lay the feed trough into the base.



4. Bolt end pieces into place using 5/16" x 2" bolts. (Do not tighten completely)
5. Bolt side panels into place using 5/16" x 2" bolts. (Do not tighten completely)



6. Using the last two 5/16" x 1" bolts, bolt the side panels together at the bottom center.
7. Using the C-brackets, fasten the side panels to the end pieces using 5/16" x 2" bolts. Tighten all bolts.



Your feeder is now assembled!
